- (iii) Bangalore Division, South Western Railway, Bangalore.
- (iv) The Application form can be downloaded from Website at www.swr.indianrailways.gov.in and printed application form should be in the **A4** size and should be filled in relevant columns with ball point pen.
- (v) The candidates who have registered with local employment exchange falling in Karnataka and adjoining districts of states, served by South Western Railway i.e. Tamilnadu, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra & Goa are eligible to apply.
- (vi) For the wards of Railway Employees and wards of retired Rly. Employees such registration however will not be required & they are eligible to apply.
- (vii) The engagement of trainees will be made on the basis of the following designated trades.

Note 1:- There are 22 candidates having “ SCVT “ certificates in 09 Fitters Trade and 13 Electricians Trade who are undergoing training for two years apprenticeship Training, hence the notification is for 583 candidates duly deducting 22 slots out of allotted slots.

Note 2 : Out of 583 slots, 3 % slots are reserved for **Persons with Disability** candidates & 3% for Ex-Servicemen quota respectively. The eligibility conditions for PWD & Ex-Serviceman Quota candidates are indicated below.

1.A. Eligibility for Person with Disability:

a) Out of 583 slots, 3 % of total No. (i.e.17 slots) of Apprentices to be trained is reserved for PWD Quota. Persons under the following physical standards as per the provisions of Schedule-II of Apprenticeship manual and Railway Boards letter No.E(MPP) 2003/06/14 dated 09.12.2003

b) **Standards of fitness for the Physically challenged candidates:**

Only Loco motor or Cerebral palsy (OH) who suffers from not less than 40% of relevant disability and Hearing Handicapped having 60 decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequency are eligible to apply.

(i) For Loco motor or Cerebral palsy (OH) :

- 1) Fitter:- Lower limb partially damaged from one side can join.
- 2) Turner : - Lower limb partially damaged from one side can join.
- 3) Machinist: - Only small finger damaged can join.
- 4) Welder :- A person without leg and without three finger of one hand can be accommodated.
- 5) Electrician: - Partially lower limb can be accommodated.
- 6) Painter :- One upper and Lower limb partially damaged.
- 7) PASAA :- Both lower limbs damaged.

(ii) Low Vision:- “Person with low vision” means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive correction but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device.

A physically handicapped person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation would have to submit a disability certificate issued by a competent authority (i.e. Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or State Government)

(Authority RBE No.213/03 dated 09.12.2003 issued under CPO/SWR Serial Circular No.230/2003 dated 31.12.2003/22.01.2004). **Other than above mentioned categories, Physically Handicapped Candidates should not apply and they will be rejected at any point of engagement.**

1.B. . Eligibility for Ex-Servicemen Quota :

- i) Children of deceased/disabled Ex-servicemen including those killed/disabled during peace time.
- ii) Children of Ex-Servicemen.
- iii) Children of serving Jawans.
- iv) Children of serving officers.
- v) Ex service men

Authority : RBE No.101/2006- (Rly.Bd letter No.E(MPP)2002/6/10) dt. 31/07/2006

Out of 583 slots 3% of total number (i.e. 17 slots) of Apprentices to be trained are Reserved for Ex-Servicemen quota.

Armed Forces Personnel must submit Discharge Certificate and in case of children of Ex-servicemen and children of Armed Forces Personnel they must submit discharge certificate of his/her parents.

2) Age Limit:

- a) Candidate should have completed 15 years of age and should not have Completed 24 years of age as on **17/08/2015**.
OC : Candidates should born between 17/08/1991 and 16/08/2000.
SC/ST : Candidates should born between 17/08/1986 and 16/08/2000.
OBC : Candidates should born between 17/08/1988 and 16/08/2000.
- b) There will be upper age relaxation of 05 years for SC/ST & 03 years for OBC candidates.

3) Educational Qualification:

“Matriculation (Matriculate or 10th Class in 10+2 examination system) and ITI Certificate affiliated to NCVT/SCVT is compulsory in relevant trade.

4) Training period & stipend:

The candidates possessing 10th + ITI in SCVT are required to undergo apprenticeship training for 02 Yrs (for other trades) and 1½ years (for welder Trades) and candidates possessing 10th + ITI in NCVT will undergo one year Apprenticeship training (Authority : RDH/STAT/POL.MATT/02/2004/770 dated 03.08.2012) and same is as under.

5) MODE OF APPLICATION:

- The applications in the prescribed Performa should be filled in the relevant columns with ball point pen in foolscap paper. The application should be accompanied with two self addressed covers – size 11" x 5" duly affixing Rs.5/- Postal Stamp on each cover. (SC/ST and PH candidates are exempted from affixing Stamps).
- Two recent passport size photographs should accompany the application form **duly signed across by the candidate**. One Photograph should be affixed on the application in the space provided and another on the Call letter.
- All Certificates i.e. Birth Certificate, Educational/ Technical qualification, Caste Certificate etc. **should be self attested**.
- The applicants will have to register with a local employment exchange falling in the states of Karnataka and the adjoining districts of states served by the South Western Railway i.e. Tamil Nadu (Districts Namely Dharmapuri, Salem, Vellore), Andhra Pradesh (Districts namely Ananthapur, Chittoor), Maharashtra (District namely Sangli) and Goa (As per CPO/SWR letter No.SWR/P.563/Act.App/Vol.6 dated 25.09.2012)
- However for wards of Railway employees such registration with local employment exchange will not be required (As per CPO/SWR letter No.SWR/P.563/Act.App/Vol.6 dated 25.09.2012) and **there should be clear indication in application & on envelope that the candidate is ward of Railway employee,** as a proof candidate must enclose **SERVICE CERTIFICATE/DECLARATION from the Railway employee which should be issued by the Gazetted Officer of the concerned unit.**

06. Where to Submit the APPLICATION:

Applications received through RPAD/Courier will not be entertained and will be summarily rejected.**

07. Last date of application :

The last date for submission of application is **16/09/2015 at 17.00 Hrs.** Application received after the due date is liable to be rejected.

8. MODE OF ENGAGEMENT:

- The Engagement of Act Apprentices will be done in favor of the candidates who have passed Matriculation or 10th Class under 10+2 system or its equivalent with ITI passed certificate in the relevant trade. The applications received with other than the prescribed educational qualifications will not be entertained.
- The final eligibility list will be prepared based on the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in Metric or 10th standard in 10+2 examination system. (CPO/SWR letter No.SWR/P.563/Act.App/Vol. 5 dated 09/11.03.2012)
- The candidates who are found eligible will have to confirm to the standards of physical fitness, as prescribed for engagement to the relevant trades on the railways (As per Master Circular No.8). If candidate is declared unfit in Medical Examination due to any reason, he/she will not be considered/directed for Re-Medical Examination.

8. CONDITIONS:

- i) **THE CANDIDATES WHOSE ITI RESULTS ARE AWAITED AS ON THE DATE OF NOTIFICATION ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO APPLY.**
- ii) **The candidates failed in ITI should not apply, in case any failed candidate is engaged un-noticed then he/she will be terminated from training without any further notice.**
- iii) The Candidates attending this office for verification will not be given any TA/DA.
- iv) No hostel facility will be provided and the selected candidates should make their own Arrangements for stay during their training.
- v) **THERE IS NO JOB ASSURANCE IN RAILWAYS TO AN APPRENTICE WHO COMPLETES THE APPRENTICESHIP SUCCESSFULLY AS PER RULE 8 OF APPRENTICESHIP RULE 1961.**
- vi) The candidates shall have to execute a contract of Apprenticeship under the Apprentices Act –1961 and if such candidate is minor his Guardian can execute the prescribed contract.
- vii) The candidates undergoing training should deposit their original SSLC/10th/ITI marks card with this office until the completion of their training so that candidates should not leave training in between.
- viii) The caste Certificate should be in central format and category against which candidate is applying must note that the sub-caste should appear in central gazette of India otherwise application will be rejected.
- ix) The applications except for the wards of Railway employees have to be registered with local Employment exchange falling in districts of Karnataka and adjoining districts of states served by S.W.Railway i.e. Tamil Nadu (districts namely Dharmapuri, Salem, Vellore), Andhra Pradesh (Districts namely Ananthapur, Chittoor), Maharashtra (district namely Sangli) and Goa (With up to date renewal). However, **application not registered with local employment exchange will be rejected (As per CPO/SWR/UBL letter No.SWR/P.569/Apprentice/Vol.VI dated 25.09.2012).**

Note :

- (a) The decision of the Administration is final and binding in the engagement of candidates for training. If the declaration submitted by the candidate is found to be false at a later date the candidature will be cancelled without any notice at any level.
- (b) A check list has been given at column no.14 of the application for self verification. It is the responsibility of the applicant to confirm themselves that they have fulfilled all the conditions stipulated in the notification before submitting the application.
- (c) Under Apprenticeship Rule 8, 1991, it is notified that it shall not be obligatory on part of employer to offer any employment to apprentices on completion of period of his/her apprenticeship training in his establishment nor shall it be obligatory on the part of the apprentice to accept an employment under the employer.
- (d) No Correspondence will be entertained from the candidate nor from any Association in relation to the application nor any reply will be given by the Administration in this regard. Applications received after due date will not be entertained. Chief Workshop Manger / Central Workshop, Mysore South is not responsible for any delay in Postal Transit & wrong delivery of applications etc.
- (e) At most care will be taken for finalizing the final list of eligible candidates, in case of any oversight the administration has right to change it at any level and decision of administration is final.
- (f) The entire process of engagement functions impersonally without fear or favor. There is no scope for influence or discretion. Hence, the rejected candidates will not be given any explanation. The short listed candidates will be informed about their nomination through ordinary post and exhibited on the notice board.

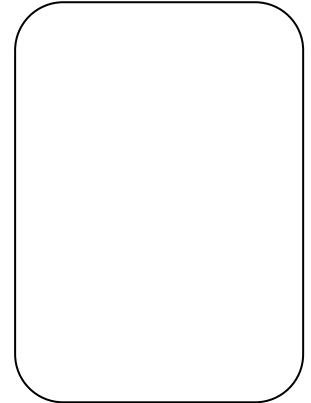
